"Group is like my family" is often repeated on Tuesday afternoon. But have you heard about this: There's a growing industry in many countries. It is called Rent-A-Family. Some use the service to maintain appearances, so that at social events they can seem to have a happy family. Others hire actors to impersonate estranged relatives, in order to feel, if briefly, a connection they long for.

We don't rent a family in Group. The people seated around this table are not hired to be here. And they are not impersonating anyone. They resemble a for-real family. They are genuine. They love, share, have compassion and know how to cry and laugh together. Like a family should be, they tell it like it is. Humans were created for, and need, companionship. In part, that's experienced with people in Group.
